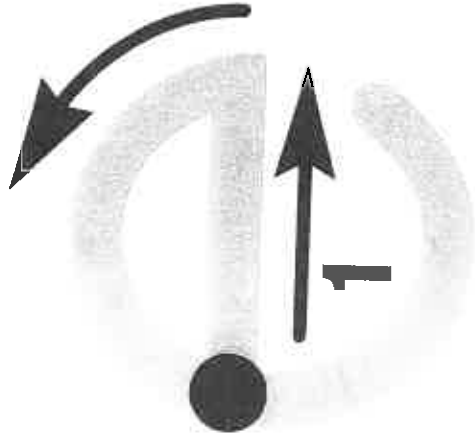
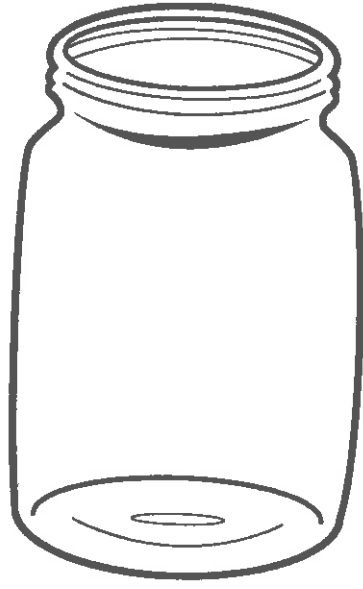


Writing With Elbows

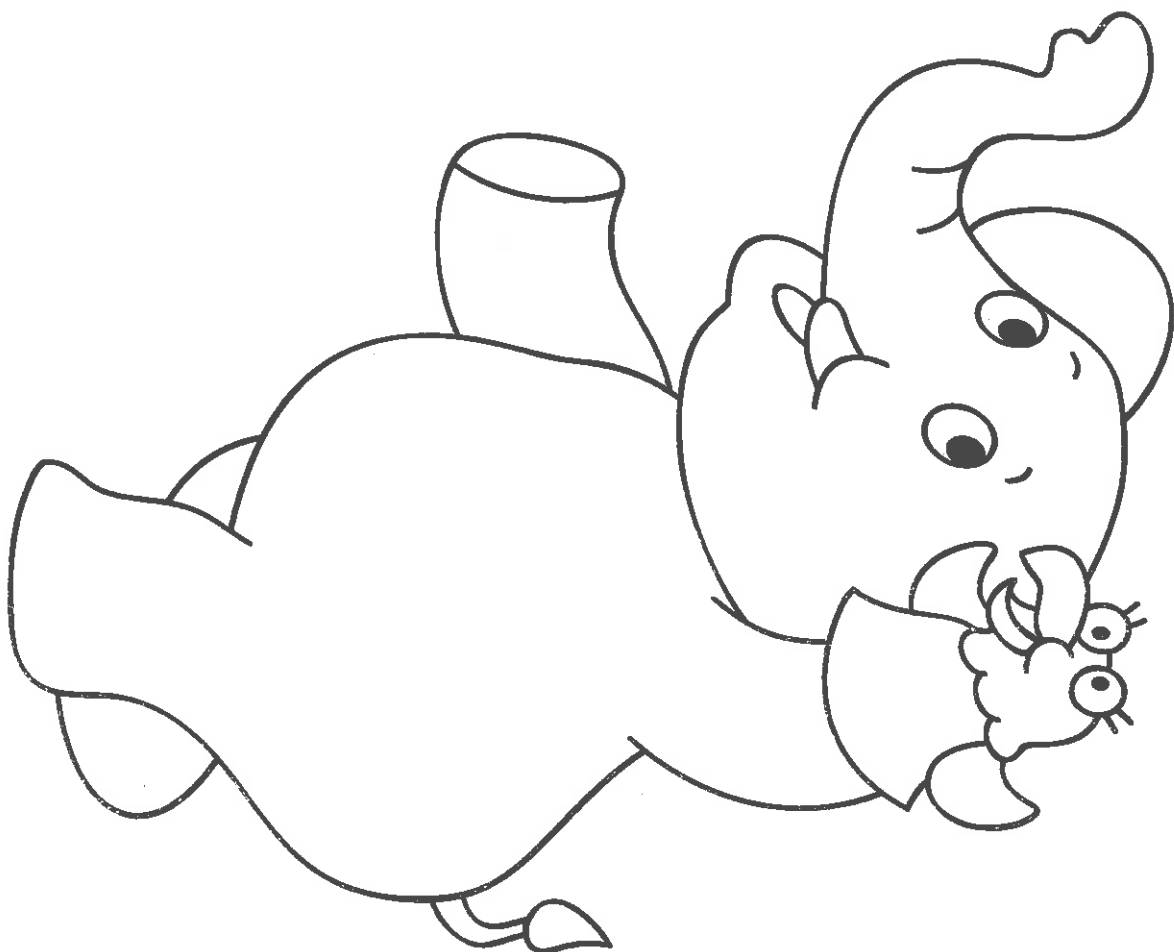
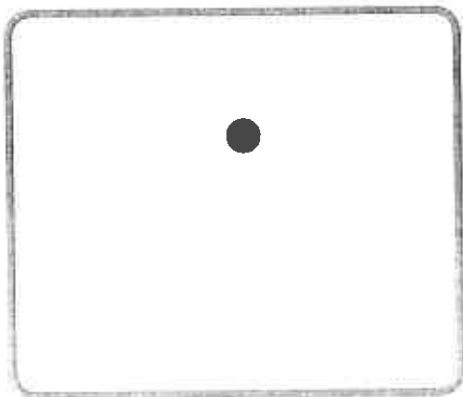
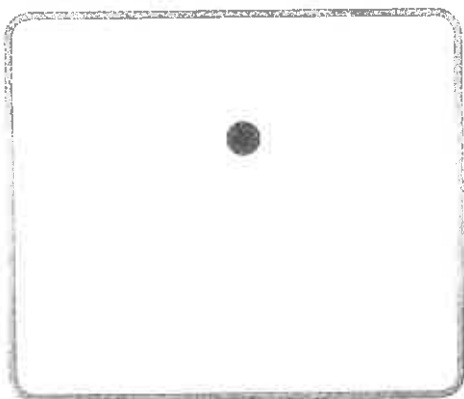
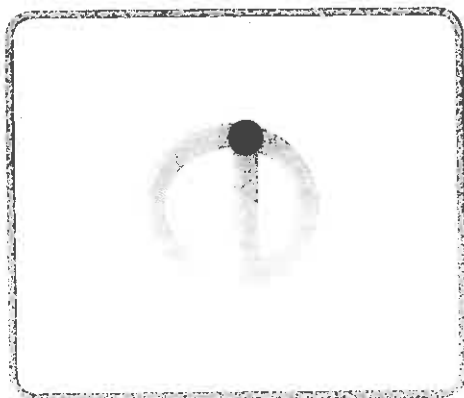
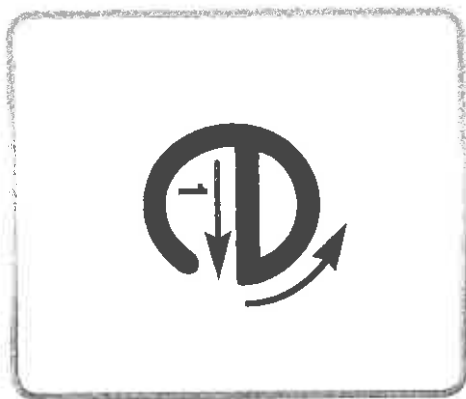
e is for empty.

Directions: The jar is empty. Everything has spilled. Encourage your child to draw a picture of what has spilled from the jar.

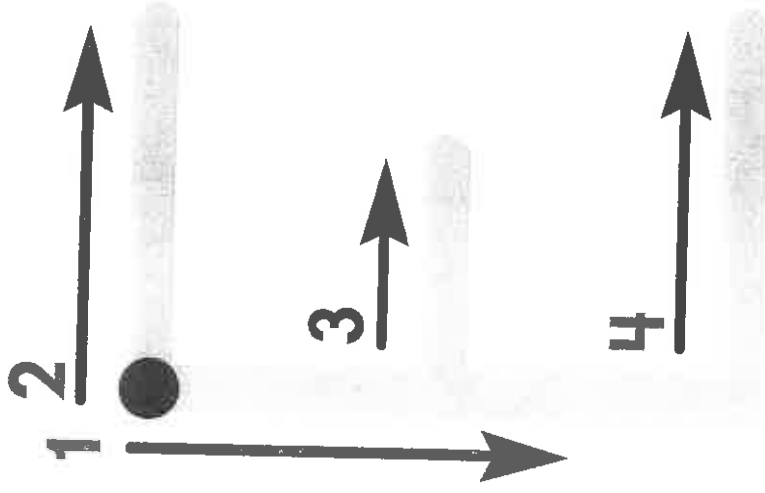

Directions: Ask children to trace and write lowercase **e** in the boxes above. Encourage them to color the elephant and the eagle as they name each one aloud.

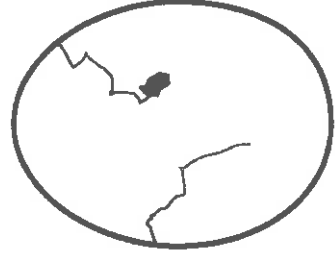
Animal Writing
