Preschool Distance Learning Folder

Curriculum created by the teachers will either be play-based, hands-on, or disseminated via paper copy. Instruction by the teacher(s) will be delivered by video format through class dojo or by using the elementary distance learning portal on our school website (www.springfield.mmtm.org).

Student folders and hard copy resources will be available for parent pick up at the elementary office each Monday in order to maintain social distancing guidelines. Online resources will be accessible by 8:10 am on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday's for the 4-5 year-olds and by 8:10 am on Tuesday and Thursday's for the 3-4 year-olds. Completed work or activities can be submitted to Miss Amber by simply taking a picture of the worksheet or the student completing the hands-on activity and send it to Miss Amber through class dojo or e-mail by noon the following school day. Students will be expected to meet the daily/weekly deadlines for completion of work or activities in order for attendance of that school day to be granted (submitted by noon the day after being assigned).

Weekly Lesson Plans Hand-Out:

Each Week you will find a calendar in your folder and on the distance learning portal. This calendar will have the assignments listed by day. Each lesson should take about 20 minutes. The lessons found under the given day, are the required assignments for the week - There is 1 lesson for each day your preschooler would be attending school that week (if your child attends school on M/W/F - they have 1 lesson Monday, 1 lesson Wednesday, and 1 lesson Friday or if your child attends on T/TH - they have 1 lesson on Tuesday and 1 lesson on Thursday), and these are the lessons that require a picture being sent to Miss Amber through Class Dojo or E-mail. You'll also notice there are 9 optional additional practice options on the bottom of the calendar - **please note these are not required and we do not want pictures of these options.**
