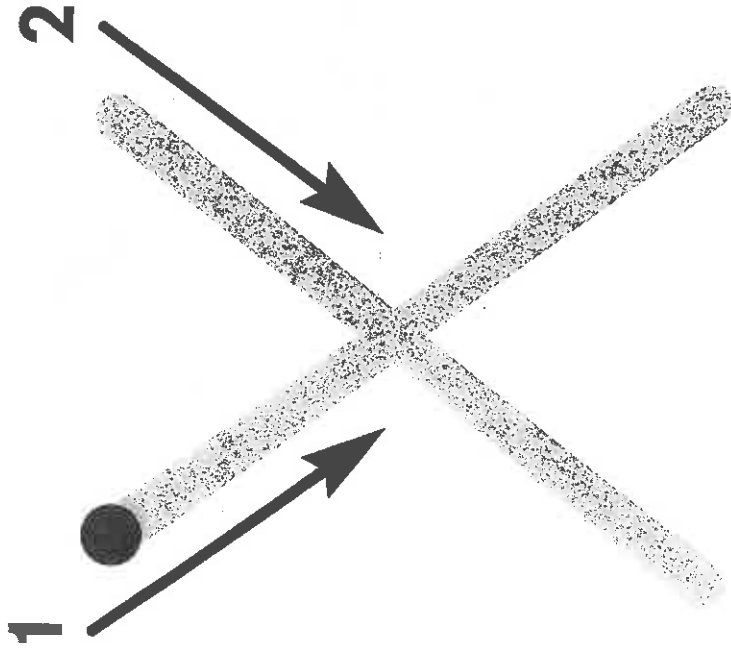


X-ray Writing

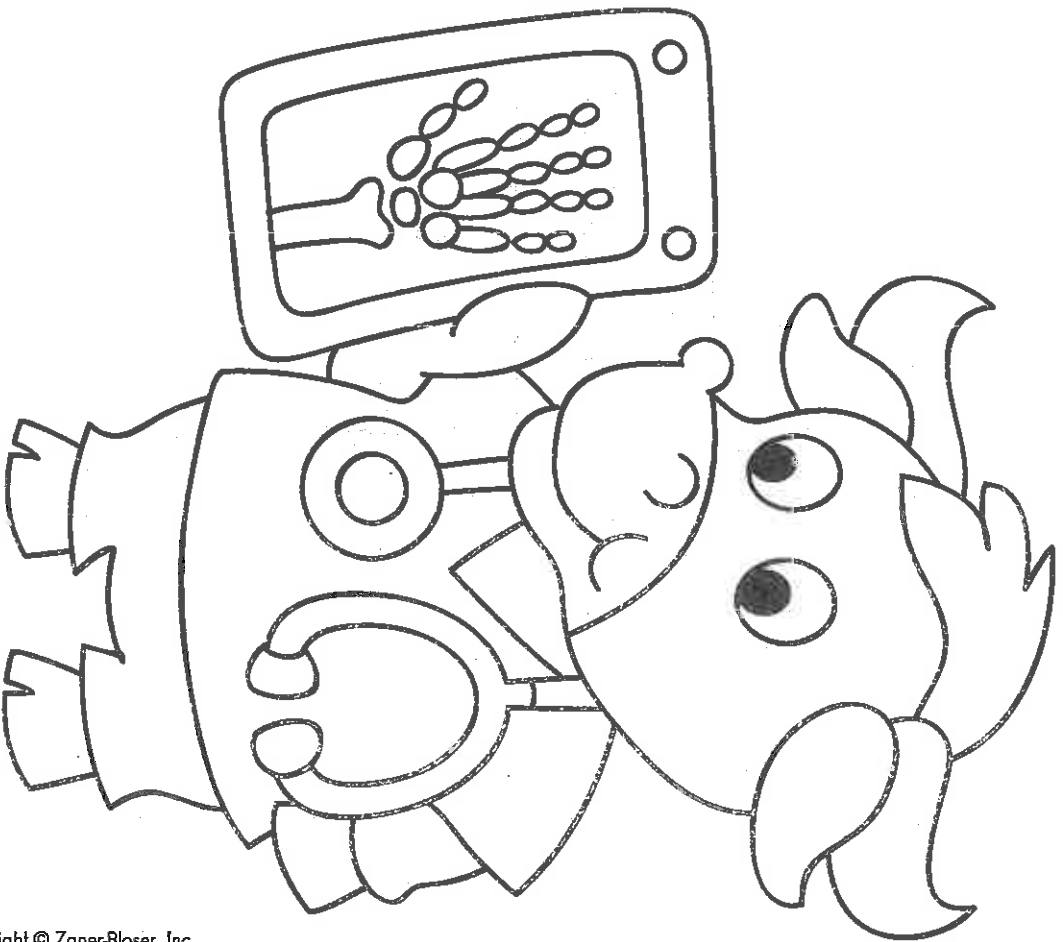
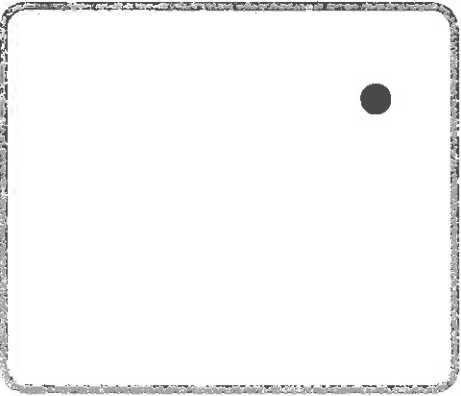
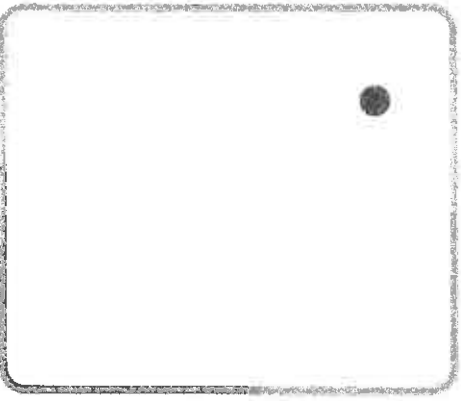
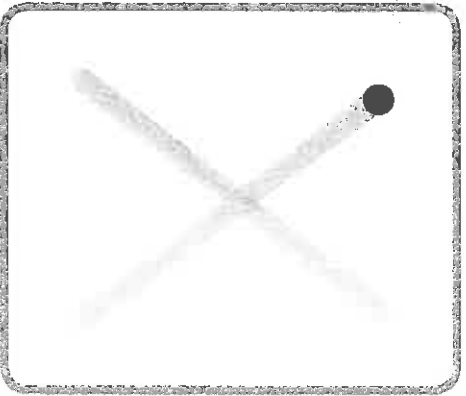
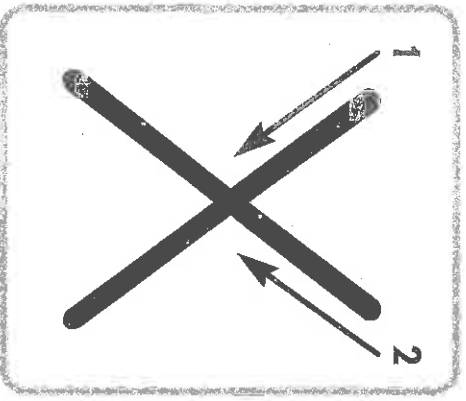
X is for x-ray.



Directions: Ask your child to trace uppercase **X** with white paint. When the paint dries, have your child use black crayon to draw a square around **X** and gently color the space around the letter to make an **X** x-ray.

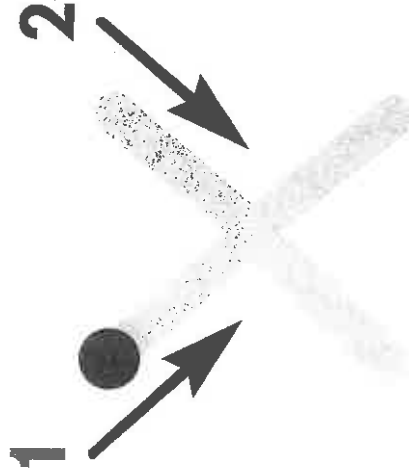


Directions: Ask children to trace and write uppercase **X** in the boxes above. Encourage them to color the ox and the x-ray as they name each one aloud.

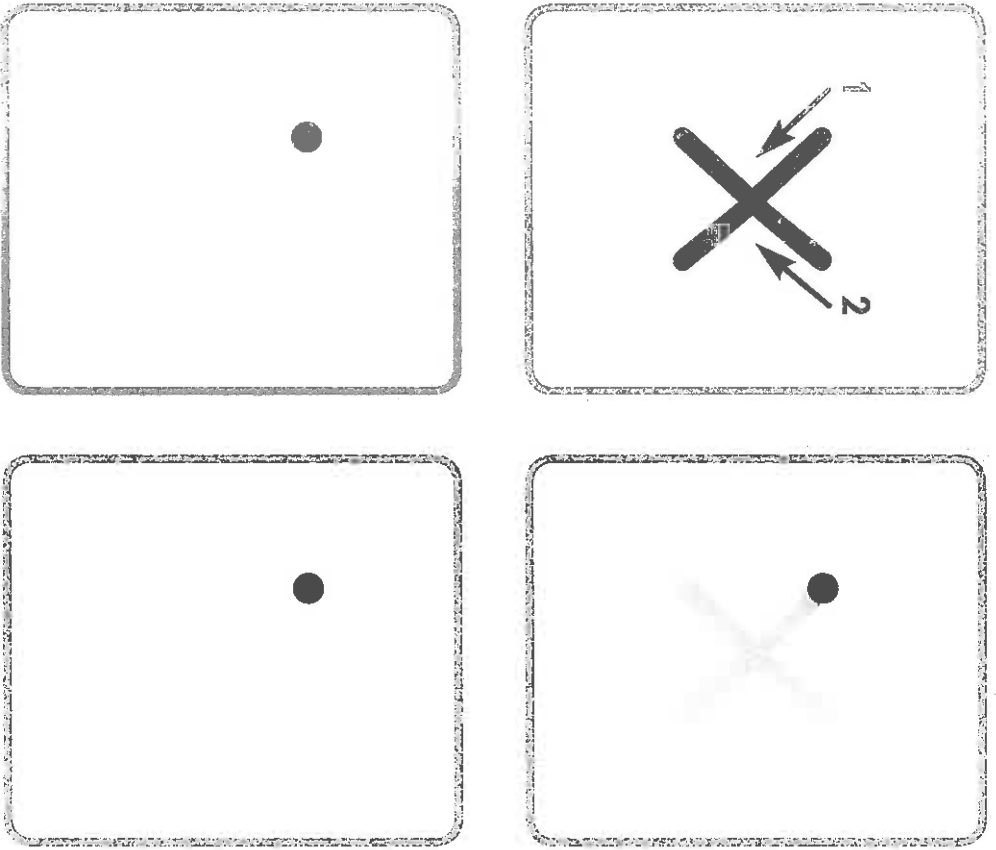
Directions: Ask your child to trace lowercase **x** with his or her favorite colored marker. Encourage him or her to trace the letter two more times, using a different colored marker each time.
